

BASIC HANDIWALL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION SHEET

Observe all safety precautions and wear all safety equipment before proceeding.

1. The easiest way to install HANDIWALL is from the floor up. Start by locating the wood studs and proceed to install the first piece of HANDIWALL. Be sure to level the HANDIWALL before screwing them into the wooden studs. NOTE: Be sure to leave a ¼ inch gap between the floor and the first row of Handiwall if you are using the baseboard trim.

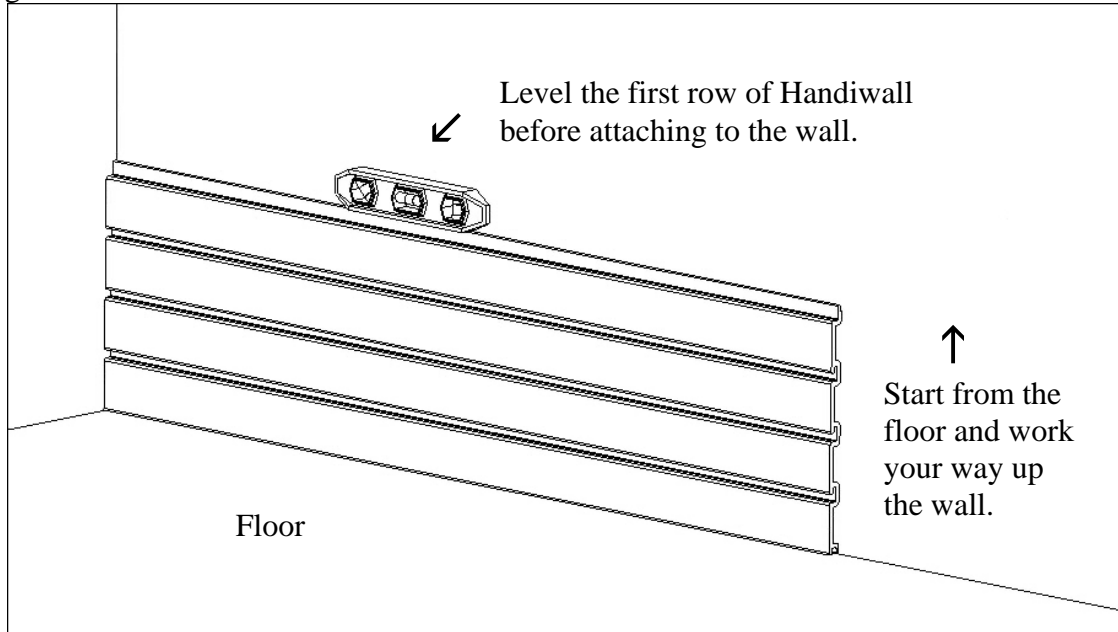


Figure 1. Level HANDIWALL before attaching it to the wall

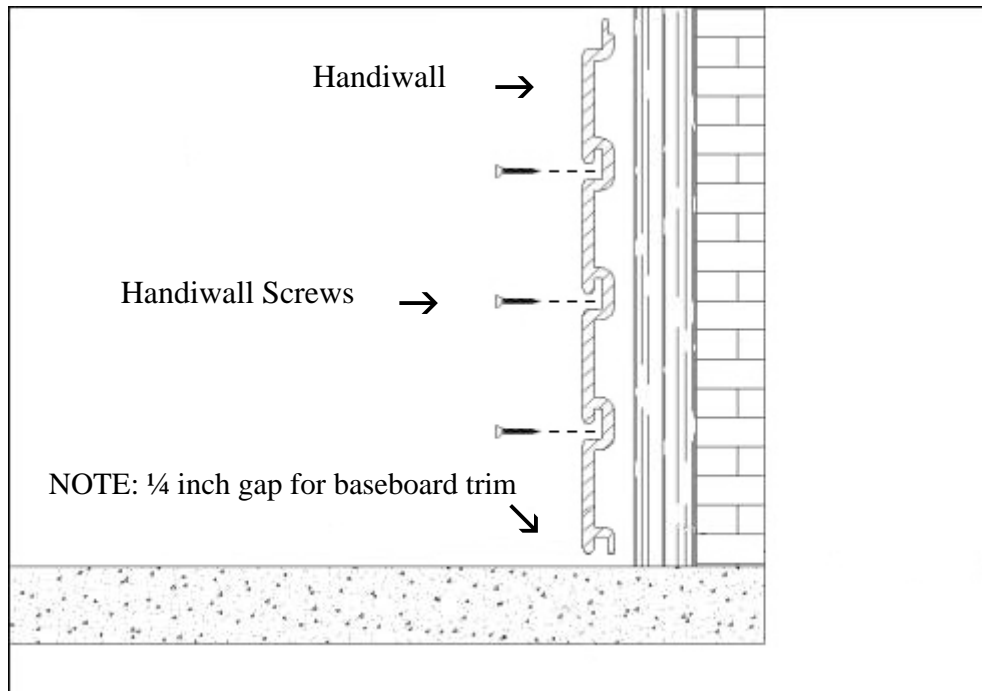


Figure 2. HANDIWALL installation.

2. Proceed to install the next HANDIWALLS on top the first leveled row. HANDIWALLS can be cut horizontally or vertically to accommodate room dimensions. Preferably using an electric saw with a thin sharp blade for HANDIWALL cutting.
